


Between November 2022 and March 2023, Greener Orkney distributed more than 300 slow cookers (including 56 to the isles) and 140 recipe books. This was made possible by an £8,000 grant from the Community Led Local Development Fund administered by Orkney Islands Council.

The project was designed to help the most vulnerable in the community by providing equipment and information about how to use less energy-intensive cooking methods.



Thanks to Tesco for their help and support in obtaining most of the slow cookers at a reduced cost, which meant that the project could reach 50% further than originally planned.

Thanks also to Restart for PAT testing donated/exchanged slow cookers so they could be redistributed



We also ran fortnightly themed recipe competitions, giving away eight £50 vouchers over the life of the project, and we published the winning recipes on social media.



At the end of the project, we estimate that if each slow cooker recipient swapped just one meal a week to the slow cooker instead of the oven, the saving would be over £18,600 per year in Orkney.
