The main activities will include:

- Liaising with community groups and coastal cleaners who are resident on the various islands and coordinating coastal cleans and data collection for the project.
- Providing updates on the project and to present the project to local community groups.
- Providing monthly summaries on the results and documenting the outputs along with images and data analysis.

We are looking for an individual who is a self-starter and has a genuine interest in the marine environment and the collection and analysis of data.
